To this end I favor modern equipment for the public works department—such as steam shovels, steam elevators, portable concrete mixers, portable rock crushers, etc. Such machinery would enable the county to put the bulk of the convicts on paving, which would be lighter work for them than moving dire with the pick and shovel.

Modern machinery is used by private contractors everywhere on big jobs. I am by business I have found machinery a money saver—therefore a money maker. It is obliged to be the same on county work.

Fulton county is sadly behind along this line. The county has done a vast amount of work in the past, but it has bigger problems shead; and it must keep abreast of modern ideas and modern methods.
