

Mr. Young, who has made many forceful cartoons for the Hearst newspapers—and who, we hope, will make many others—is just at present in the position of the gentleman who had suddenly discovered that the earth was round and wanted to run around it and find out if it was really so.

decided to go in we assume the injuntice.

He is as enthusiastic as our young friend Upton Sinclair, who told us about nine years ago that the end of the present industrial system would come in eight years.

This is a world of injustice. Not because there are villains at the top and good, virtuous, moral people at the bottom, but because this is still a world of ignorance, and IGNORANCE is cruelty and injustice.

Mr. Young here represents capitalism—that is to say, success—eating the fat, juley fruit of prosperity, while labor, poor, deserving, virtuous little thing, stands below, getting an occasional drop of the juice.

Mr. Young has a scornful arrow pointing at the badly developed skull of capitalism, with the lines, 'That wonderful directing brain.' Young's idea is that it really is not a wonderful directing brain, just a very fat, dull brain.

But YOUNG DOESN'TE EXPLAIN HOW IT HAPPENS THAT THE DULL BRAIN ALWAYS HAS THE FRUIT.

The trouble with Mr. Young and many other earnest young men whose discovery of injustice is only recent, is that they fer-ment violently, whereas they should reason quietly. Full of sympathy and goodness, they let their emotions take charge of the machine.

It is not romantic or pleasant, but we must tell Mr. Young and his friends that as a matter of fact the man with the big fat fruit really HAS the wonderful directing brain.

If he didn't have that he wouldn't have the fruit.

The little gentleman at the bottom, representing labor, is only getting an occasional drop, not because he is an unselfish creature who doesn't want the fruit, BUT BECAUSE HE HAS NOT BEEN ABLE TO GET IT.




