

Atlanta Wins the Road Congress.

The news that Atlanta has been selected for next year's meeting of the American Road Congress brings peculiar pride to this city and hearty satisfaction to all the South. The convention will be of national importance and of immeasurable value as an influence for highway development. It will assemble five thousand delegates from every part of America, leaders and authorities in good-roads activity, and will also, be accompanied by a great exposition of road building methods and machinery. The American Road Congress is the most widely representative and efficient organization of its kind in the world. Through its Atlanta convention, it will become a definite force for good throughout the South. Atlanta was chosen among many eager competitors chiefly because of its strategic position in a territory where well-built and well-kept roads are particularly essential and where, too, public sentiment for good roads is now unusually keen. Some weeks ago, in urging Atlanta's claims for the Road Congress, The Journal pointed out the fact that Georgia is touched by five agricultural States whose interests are vitally concerned in highway extension and improvement: on the south, Florida, a mecca of tourists and home-seekers; on the west, Alabama, rich in mining as well as a farming resources; on the east. and home-seekers; on the west, Alabama, rich in mining as well as farming resources; on the east South Carolina, awhirr with cotton mills; and on the north along the Appalachian ridge, North Carolina and Tennessee abounding in natural treasure and imbu with the spirit of progress. 




