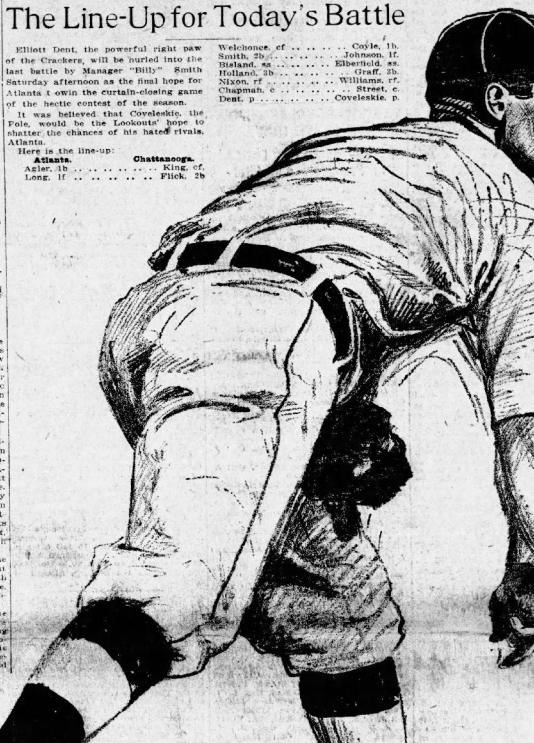

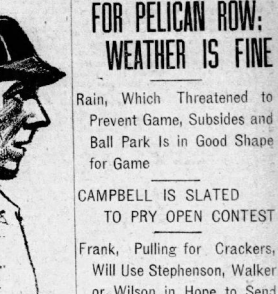
All Retaliatory Features Against Canada Removed From Proposed Tariff

Arguments for and against the pardon of Dr. J. J. McNaughton were concluded before the state prison commission late Friday afternoon and the commission took the case upon consideration. A decision will be reached sometime next week and the prevailing opinion is that the commission will decline to recommend a pardon for Dr. McNaughton, but will recommend that Governor Slaton commute his sentence to life imprisonment.

Dr. McNaughton is in the Chatham county jail under sentence to be hanged for the murder of Fred Plaford, of Emanuel county. Plaford died about three years ago under suspicious circumstances and the state contended that he died from arsenic poisoning administered by Dr. McNaughton, his family physician. The entire case against Dr. McNaughton's alleged infatuation with Mrs. Mattie Flinders, the dead man's wife.

Dr. Flinders was jointly indicted with Dr. McNaughton, but the case against her was not pressed a few weeks ago. Dr. McNaughton's case has been through all the courts, including the United States Supreme court. He has been several times respited. His attorneys have been unable to secure a writ of habeas corpus and Dr. McNaughton's attorneys contend that Flinders died of acute nephritis and explain the arsenic found in his stomach as a result of the arsenic medicine for some weeks prior to his death.

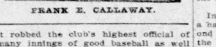
